For over 30 years civilians of Iraqi Kurdistan have been caught within cross-border conflicts as the governments of Turkey and Iran have engaged in bombing campaigns against multiple armed groups.

Villagers and migrant farmers have sustained considerable casualties, damages to property, loss of livelihoods, lasting traumatic effects as well as multiple deaths.

There is an urgent need for diplomatic peace talks between the involved parties as a means of resolving conflict in the region.

We also encourage local Governments within Iraq to investigate and find a mechanism for compensate of civilian losses.

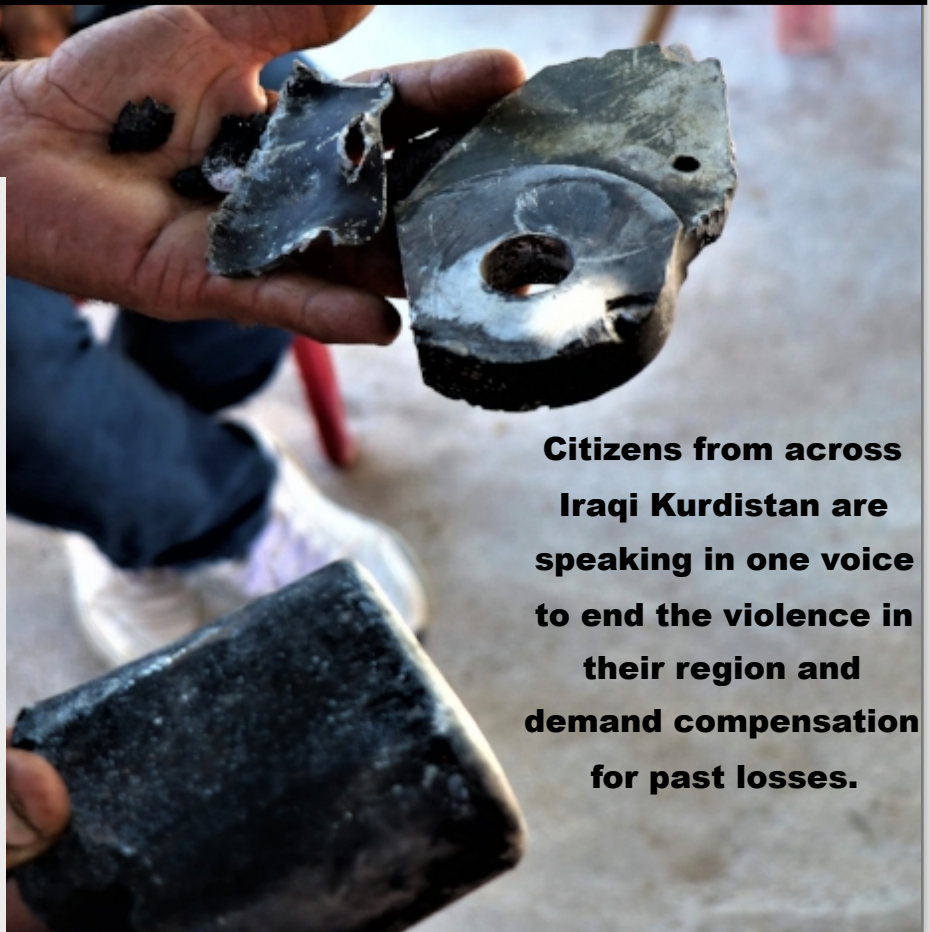

- There is an immediate end to the bombings
- All armed groups and foreign militaries withdraw from village areas
- Parliamentarians raise this issue within the Iraqi and KRG Parliaments
- Past deaths and civilian losses are investigated and compensation is made to affected families
- Those killed due to bombings are recognized as martyrs and the correct cause-of death is listed on death certificates
- Iraqi and KRG government officials meet with those affected
