

Covid Protocol For Colombia

Delegations

The following protocol contains some key elements for the effective realization of the national and international delegations carried out by the Colombia team.

Before Arriving At The Delegation:

- We limit the participation of delegates to 8 people per delegation.
- If less than 5 people register, the delegation will cancel and CPT will allocate any payment towards another delegation, either in Colombia or another program.
- The participant should bring proof of vaccination card with a minimum of 2 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine. The second dose should be taken up to 2 weeks before the start of delegation. It is preferable that the participant has had their booster, if possible.
- Prove of negative results of PCR or antigen test before leaving home/country.
- For the international delegation, recommend travel insurance - CPT cannot cover travel insurance;
- Request liability waiver in case the delegation is canceled two weeks before the delegation.

After Arrival:

- All the participants will be submitted to an antigen (rapid) test two days after arrival. While waiting for the test, mobility should be limited and you should wear a mask at all times. During that time, the delegate will have to isolate himself in a hotel.
- Sign liability exception, where CPT is not responsible in case of covid infection or death due to covid during the delegation.
- If a person has symptoms, they should get tested as quickly as possible.

Protocol During The Delegation:

- Participants should bring their own surgical mask or they can buy it in Barrancabermeja.
- In closed spaces, the use of face masks is mandatory. In open places it is important to maintain physical distance.
- CPT will provide hand sanitizer

In Case Of Contagion:

- In case a participant has COVID, CPT will cover their expenses during isolation;
- If a visit to hospital is necessary: Colombians - The delegate should find where their social security can attend them or they should be affiliated with SISBÉN. Other nationalities; ensure that their travel insurance covers their medical costs.
- CPT will designate a person from the team (other than the delegation leaders) to support the person with Covid, providing food/medication, etc)
- If half of the delegations test positive to COVID, the delegation will be canceled. CPT will cover food and lodging costs until the travel date, or the participant can change the travel date.
- In case of cancellation we can think of alternative activities depending on where the team is in its action planning and the context.
