COVID PROTOCOL

FOR PALESTINE DELEGATIONS

November ———— 2022

The following protocol contains some key elements for ensuring that the Palestine team's national and international delegations can be carried out as safely as possible.

Before Arriving At The Delegation:

- We will limit the number of delegates to 12 people per delegation.
- If less than 6 people register, the delegation will be canceled, and CPT will allocate any payments towards another delegation in Palestine or another CPT program.
- For the international delegation, CPT will recommend but not cover travel insurance
- We will request a liability waiver if the delegation is canceled two weeks before the delegation.

After Arrival:

- All participants will do a COVID-19 test if anyone in the delegation tests positive.
- All participants will sign a liability exception, indicating that CPT is not responsible in the case of COVID-19 infection or death due to COVID-19 during the delegation.
- If a person has symptoms, they should get tested as quickly as possible, either with a COVID-19 home test or PCR.

- If a person has COVID-19, they will quarantine in one of the CPT apartment rooms for a minimum of 5 days. They may rejoin the group after 5 days but must wear a mask if still symptomatic.
- Masks are not required unless one of the group members has COVID-19 or has symptoms.
- CPT will provide hand sanitizer and masks.

In Case Of Contagion:

- In the case that a participant has COVID-19, CPT will cover their expenses during isolation.
- CPT will designate a person from the team (other than the delegation leaders) to support the person with COVID-19 and provide food, medication, etc.
- If two thirds of the delegation tests positive for COVID-19, the delegation will be canceled. CPT will cover food and lodging costs until the travel date, or the participant can change the travel date.
- In case of cancellation, we can think of alternative activities depending on where the team is in its action planning and the context.
- Other decisions can be made by the Palestine team if something unexpected happens.
